THE NORTHAMPTONSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (PUBLIC FOOTPATH LE4
(PART) – PARISH OF YARDLEY HASTINGS)
(TEMPORARY CLOSURE) ORDER 2021

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Northamptonshire County Council have made an Order the effect of which is to prohibit pedestrians proceeding along that length of Public Footpath LE4 (Part) in the Parish of Yardley Hastings as specified below. Private access to land or premises adjacent to the said length of footpath are unaffected.

RIGHT OF WAY TO WHICH RESTRICTION APPLIES: The existing route of Footpath LE4 (Part) to be closed begins at NGR SP 8613 5617 (point A on the plan) and extends in a generally southerly direction for 470 metres to NGR SP 8606 5574 (point B on plan). The route to be closed is shown by means of solid black line between points A and B.

REASONS FOR RESTRICTION: The restriction is required for construction works on dam spillway and associated vehicular traffic movements on footpath.

PERIOD OF CLOSURE: The Order will come into effect on 15th February 2021 and will continue in force for a period of six months. An application may be made for the approval of the Secretary of State for Transport for this Order to be extended if this proves necessary. However, the restriction specified will have effect only at such times and to such extent as is indicated by the display of notices.

ALTERNATIVE ROUTES: There is no suitable alternative route.
